## Summer League

### What is it?

Gwinnett County is home to one of the top 10 summer swim leagues in that nation. Neighborhoods and clubs form swim teams of boys and girls ages 5-18. These teams compete against each other at their home pools. The top 50 swimmers in each age group boys and girls then swim in the county meet at the end of the season.

### Who will be the Coaches?

Rick and Heidi Creed who together have over 50 years of coaching experience. Rick has been coach of the year five times and has won many state and county championships. Heidi has coached USS swimming at the collegiate level, year round level and summer league. We have the "Best of the Best" in coaching and they are residents of CE.

### When do you swim?

Practices are each day Monday thru Friday at a specific time for each age group. Usually in the mornings before the pool opens for the day.

Meets are Thursday nights from the end of May until the first week of July. There are three home meets and three away meets. Teams are selected by geographical locations. We are in the north division and could swim against teams from Hamilton Mill, Dacula, Suwanee, Lawrenceville or Duluth.

### What defines a swimmer?

A swimmer is a child who can swim the length (long distance 25 yards) of the pool alone, under their own power.

Swimmers ages 5 - 10 swim 25 yards events; swimmers 11-18 swim 50 yards events.
