Men's Club Championship 2010 Results

Dave Wilder held off a valiant comeback by David Ard to capture his 5th straight and 9th overall Club Championship. As the final round began Wilder held a five shot lead over Ard and a six shot lead over newly joined member Ben Bramlett. Wilder and Bramlett ran into trouble early and by the fifth hole the lead had been cut to two by Ard. They both found the fairway on the sixth, but Wilder was away. He hit a six iron to the middle of the green; it took one hop, checked and rolled 5 feet right into the hole for an eagle. With the green being elevated none of the players saw the shot go in. Ard proceeded to come up just short and to the right of the green. Knowing that Wilder had just made two, he hit a great chip that just skirted past the right of the hole and by 5 feet. He hit a great putt, but the ball never broke on the tricky surface so his three shots he had made up were erased. But he fought back with a birdie on #7 to climb back within four. The lead remained at four until hole #15 where Ard holed out his flop shot from behind the bunkers to cut the lead to three. Heading into the short 16th, Ard drove the ball pin high but the ball hung up in the rough on the down slope to a short-sided pin with an almost impossible shot. Wilder continued his steady play by hitting the fairway and the green to increase the pressure even more. Ard needing a birdie went for it and hit a good shot, but it released into the back bunker. Wilder just missed his birdie effort and Ard ended up making bogey to fall behind by four again. Ard rebounded again with a long distance putt for birdie on #17 to draw back within three heading into the final hole. Ard's tee shot found the right rough in between the trees, while Wilder hit his tee shot right down the middle and onto the center of the green, showing why he has won nine titles.

Congratulations to Dave Wilder for his great playing to defend his title once again.

The first Blue flight was a closely contested battle. Charles Zino headed into the final hole with a two shot lead, but hit an errant second shot out of bounds to open the door for Dale Gaines to win by one shot over himself and Alan Couch.

The second Blue flight had nine players within 4 shots of leader Ted Versteeg. Versteeg never could find his swing the last round and relinquished the lead early. Steve Poe shot an 82 final round to edge out Robbie White by one shot.

The third Blue flight had 10 guys within 3 shots of the leaders Larry Galaviz, Harry Gentry and Mike Lancaster. Lancaster was able to shoot a great final round of 78, to edge out Scott Vinson who also had a great round of 79 by two strokes.

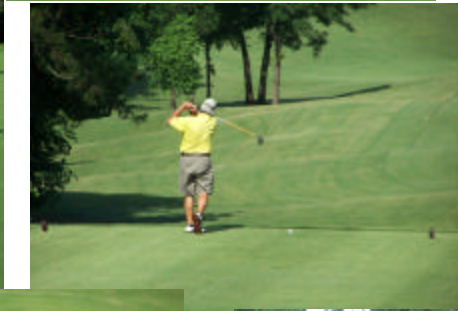
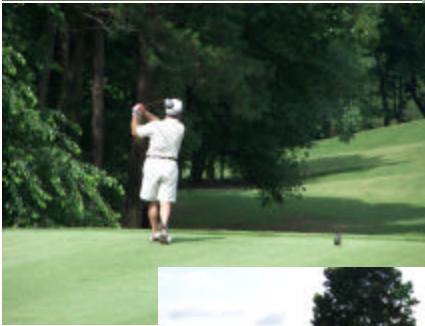
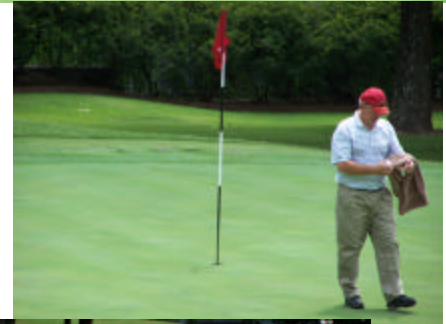

But in the net division Carl Williams held a one shot lead over Emery Baker and a four shot lead over Terry Roof. Emery played a great final round of 85 to capture the net title by five shots, while Nebbia shot a final round 81 to win the gross division by 15 shots.

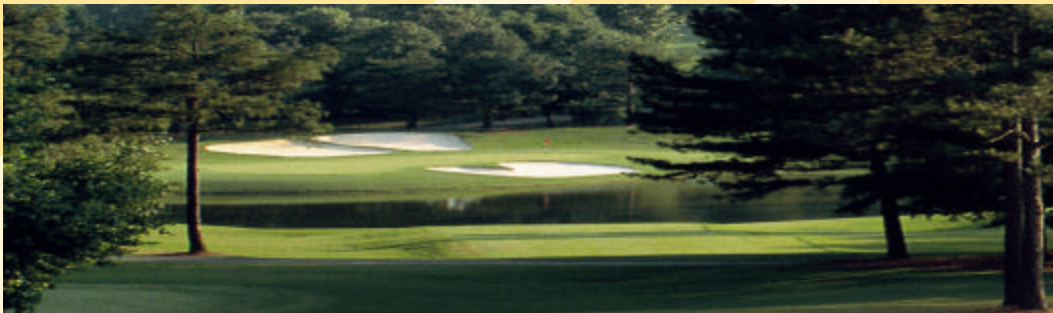
